

SCHEDULE '1' TO THE ARTICLES OF CONTINUANCE (FORM 4031)

CRA Approved Purposes – ISNA Canada

1. To advance and teach the religious tenets, doctrines and observances associated with the Islamic faith by:
 - a. Establishing, maintaining and operating places of worship;
 - b. Establishing and maintaining cemeteries in adherence to the Islamic faith and tradition, as well as conducting funeral and burial services and related services in observance of Islamic traditions including the washing, purification, and transportation of the deceased;
 - c. Establishing and maintaining a halal certification service which would educate and ensure compliance with the Islamic dietary requirements on the part of vendors and consumers;
 - d. Educating the Canadian Muslim community and the wider Canadian community about Islam, , by holding conferences, seminars and/or exhibits, and collecting and disseminating information about Islam; and
 - e. Establishing and operating bookstores as a source of Islamic books, texts and other written information and publications, and cultural items (e.g. prayer mats, beads and other related items).

2. To receive bequests, trusts, funds, and property, and to hold, invest administer and distribute funds and property for the purposes of the Society as presently set out and for such other organizations as are “qualified donees” under the provisions of Income Tax Act.

3. To advance religion by alleviating poverty in accordance with the tenets and doctrines of Islam by:
 - a. Operating a foodbank for individuals or families who are poor, of low income or in need; and
 - b. Providing basic necessities of life including food, clean water, and/or clothing to individuals or families who are poor, of low income or in need.

4. To establish and facilitate the maintenance and operation of one or more multi-use facilities for the Canadian Muslim community which will:
 - a. Provide community services and outreach programs, including but not limited to, family and individual counselling, community recreation and general interest programs of benefit to the Canadian Muslim community;
 - b. Be used for religious ceremonies, programs and studies for children, youth , adults and seniors;
 - c. Be used to provide matrimonial services and religious education and support about the Islamic principles related to marriage and family; and
 - d. Be used to address and prevent specific problems faced by families by providing parents, youth and children with counselling and mentoring programs, workshops and seminars on issues such as depression, anxiety, anger management, conflict resolution and/or effective communication.

5. To advance education by providing publicly available scholarships, bursaries, and other forms of financial assistance to Muslim high school and university students to be used for post-secondary education.

6. To improve the moral or ethical development of the Canadian community by promoting respect for human rights in accordance with Islamic principles through the following activities:

- a. facilitating debate and discussion through workshops and presentations on human rights;
- b. distributing material that increases the public's knowledge about human rights issues and abuses;
- c. creating and undertaking awareness campaigns for individuals, encouraging them to respect each other's human rights
